Fairy Tale of the Day:

Hansel and Gretel

"Hansel and Gretel" is a German fairy tale collected by the Brothers Grimm and published in 1812. It is a story about a brother and sister who are abandoned in a forest and fall into the hands of a witch who lives in a house made of bread, cake, and sugar. The witch intends to feed parts of her house to the siblings so she can cook them and eat them. Gretel outsmarts the witch and the siblings escape with her treasure at the end. This story traces back to the late middle ages (1250-1500), but no one knows exactly who told it first. Some versions have a house made of candy, gingerbread, and even cheese. There are multiple stage adaptations, the most famous of which being Engelbert Humperdinck's opera *Handel und Gretel*.
