Dear Parent/Carers,

Mount Pleasant Road Primary School (MPRPS) is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of MPRPS parent payment arrangements for 2021.

The preferred method of payment is through Sentral. On your account you will notice <u>four payment instalments</u>, if you would like to make a full payment please select **all four options**. If you wish to pay by instalments select the first option only, a reminder will be sent out on Sentral when the next instalment is due. Payment by credit card, cash and eftpos is still available at Reception.

MPRPS makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

Schools are funded to deliver a quality education based on the standard curriculum. School Council is very proud of the quality of education and extensive programs we offer to meet the learning needs, interests and capabilities of all students. Parent payments are a valuable contribution to enhancing and enriching the educational experience of all children. These payments allow schools to offer enhanced programs and opportunities which their school communities expect them to offer. Schools decide on the learning program they offer based on the needs and aspirations of the school community. You can be asked to pay for **Essential Student Learning Items** that the school deems essential to student learning in the standard curriculum including:

- items which students take temporary or permanent possession of, including text books, reading material, work sheets, student stationery and software subscriptions
- materials for learning and teaching where students construct, consume or take possession of the finished articles (for example, art materials, gardening and cooking, construction)
- activities that all students are expected to attend (e.g. Life Education and School Production)

At the present time, the only <u>Voluntary Contributions</u> we ask from parents are for a <u>Building Fund and Library Fund</u>. These are contributions that have been endorsed by the Australian Taxation Office as Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) and are tax deductible. The funds go towards the purchase of books for your child to read at home and at school and to maintain and upgrade facilities.

<u>Optional Items</u> are items or services that are offered in addition to the standard curriculum. These items are provided on a user-pays basis and individual notices will be sent home as these events occur. Examples of these items include: school photos, fees for guest speakers, extra-curricular programs or activities such as instrumental music tuition, Wise Ones, I.C.E., excursions, incursions, sport competitions and camps.

Below is the outline of MPRPS student's costs for the 2021 school year. These monies contribute to the resources for your child's education for the whole year. Classroom items (student consumables) are purchased in bulk which significantly reduces the cost and means that every student is using the same materials in the classroom and feel that they belong.

Students' supplies will be distributed at the beginning of the year to allow items to be named/covered in the first week of school. During the year we will also provide your child/children with art supplies, paper (writing, plain, copy, cover), textbooks, science, maths and technology equipment and consumables, online programs, musical instruments for Performing Arts classes, physical education equipment and sports uniforms for specific sports played against other schools.
