The two largest components of the SOP are social distancing while on property and sanitizing equipment and facilities. We have formalized that process and it's likely you will see staff on site carrying out the procedures. We hope you will appreciate the effort we are putting into this process and help us by being patient during these trying times.

A small but significant change you will see at the BC are staff uniforms. You will be able to discern staff by their boonie hats, KBBC logo shirts and walkie talkies. Please feel free to approach them with any guestions you may have. They are on site to make your experience better.

As an update, Beachside Café, the new snack bar operator, was stymied by the State's inability to inspect our facility during the height of the pandemic.
