


BEACH RULES Operating Hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

ALLOWED

Social Distancing

Allow 6 feet of social distancing between people of different households.





X NOT ALLOWED

Gatherings No gathering of people from different households.



No gathering in changing rooms, picnic pavilions (Closed).






Facial Coverings

Must be worn when social distancing of 6 feet cannot be achieved, except for same-household members.

Walking and Jogging

Walkers should maintain social distancing of 6 feet while wearing facial coverings. Joggers to maintain minimum of 12 feet from others and may lower facial covering.



Swimming/Surfing /Paddle-Boarding/Kayaking

Facial coverings are not required while in the ocean.



Sunbathing

Limited to family members from the same household.

Outdoor Showering

While waiting, and walking to and from showers, maintain social distancing and wear facial coverings.



Special Events No parties or group picnics.

Organized Athletics/Activities

No volleyball, football, soccer, frisbee, paddle ball, etc.



Sharing Equipment

No sharing of beach chairs, umbrellas, coolers, etc. among people from different households.

Exercise Equipment No use of outdoor exercise equipment.

Pets No dogs or other pets on the beach.













Concessions

All individuals waiting in line at concession stands must practice social distancing and wear facial coverings.



Fishing

No surf fishing on the beach.

Except at: Haulover Park south seawall and west Intracoastal Waterway; Rickenbacker Pier; South Pointe Pier and Government Cut; Bal Harbour Jetty and Sunny Isles Fishing Pier.



BEACH USE: CDC GUIDELINES AND OTHER REMINDERS

Facial Coverings

- Facial coverings are not required for:
 - Children under 2 years old.
 - Persons who have trouble breathing due to a chronic pre-existing condition; persons who are not able to remove face coverings without assistance.
 - Persons involved in strenuous activity; however, the person involved in strenuous activity should have a face covering in their possession and must be able to show their mask upon request by local authority.
 - While in the ocean.

NOTE: Facial coverings that are wet are ineffective. Beachgoers should bring an additional clean and dry face covering to replace a face covering that becomes wet or dirty.

Gatherings

- No gatherings of people from different households
- Individuals from different households must maintain 6 feet of social distancing per CDC guidelines
- Group size shall not exceed 10 persons at any time.

Public Safety and Enforcement

Enforcement of Beach procedures and protocols is a priority and beachgoers can be required to leave the beach if they are violating the safety requirements.
