A Sad Image at our beloved Club

I think many of you have already heard about the crime of arson committed at the BC. If not, here's what we know. In the early morning hours of January 20th, a small group of people lit 4 of our 5 chickee umbrellas on fire. The 5th chickee was singed but did not sustain any real damage. other 4 are a complete loss. The apparent perpetrators took video and posted it on Instagram. The police are working with these images and other evidence to investigate who these criminals are. Going forward, we will install security cameras in critical locations around the Club. Of course if you have any information related to this crime please contact our Manager.

For months now I have mentioned the potential opening of the Beach Side Café. I can now announce another step has been accomplished. For months, we have been struggling with the Dept. of Health related to our septic tank. Our change of tenant has triggered the need for compliancy with current standards.

When the system was put in place in 1954 it was compliant and for 6 decades we have operated without a hitch. We had the system tested, cleaned and certified SAFE. This did not satisfy the State. We have set aside the money to connect our system to the Village as soon as the Village is ready to receive us. We sent a letter, along with the Village's confirmation letter, to the State attesting to this to no avail. We

were denied at each turn. The last avenue was a variance board meeting which I attended on February 4th to plead our case. I'm happy to report that we were approved unanimously and should have our permit by the middle of this month. Before you come over with your order, we still have two inspections to go but those are more procedural and we don't expect any issues or much time to complete. In the next newsletter, I hope to announce the grand opening.
