KEY SCRIPTURE: John 15:1

READING: Deuteronomy 10:14; Psalm 24:1-2; Jeremiah 29:11

CHAPTER TWO: MY FATHER IS THE MASTER GARDENER

INTRODUCTION

"I am the true Vine, and My Father is the Gardener". John 15:1

"Whether I'm withering or flourishing, let me remember it is You, Lord, the Head Gardener, who always nourishes and protects".

The Master or head Gardener is the one who owns the vineyard, the one who provides the seeds to be planted, the one who prunes and the one who is in charge. He has the master plan. As the one who owns, tends and determines what fruit the garden ought to produce, He is entitled to receive a good return for his investment.

God our father is the intelligent designer, the master architect, the creator of the Heavens and earth and the possessor of all things. Deuteronomy 10:14 says; "Behold, to the LORD your God belong the heavens, even the highest heavens, and the earth and everything in it". And in one of the Psalms of David. Psalm 24:1-2 he wrote, "The earth is the LORD's, and the fullness thereof, the world and all who dwell therein. For He has founded it upon the seas and established it upon the waters". Your life is like a vineyard or garden before the Father, and He is the Head Gardener. God the Father as the Master Gardener is responsible for tending and keeping you. He is responsible for providing everything that you need so that you may

bear the fruit that He desires. When we recognize and surrender to Him as the Master Gardener of our lives, then we will find peace and subsequently rest for our souls.

God has a plan for your life. It's a waste of time trying to reinvent the wheel. Rather what you need to do is find out what His plan is and live it. The more you know Him, the more you will trust Him. The more you trust Him, the greater your rest. ABIDING is learning to rest in Him. Matthew 11:28 - "Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest". And in Hebrews 4:9 [TPT] We read; "So, then we must be eager to experience this faith-rest life, so that no one falls short by following the same pattern of doubt and unbelief.

Scripture is filled with God's promises to provide rest when we seek Him. God is the source of all peace and strength. He created us to be totally dependent on Him! He is our peace! He is our strength! Many Christians have problems connecting with the Gardener because of the dynamics of their upbringing. They have "father issues". Often these issues hinder us from recognizing and surrendering to Abba Father, the Master Gardener. Nevertheless, here are five key roles of the Master Gardener that we must surrender to.

- OWNER He is the owner, and you are the branch in His vineyard. He has a plan for your life.
- PROVIDER He provides seeds, water, sun etc. He is your provider. He has provided everything you need to succeed.
- PRUNING He is responsible for pruning the branches (You). He heals and He restores.
- PROTECTOR He builds fences to protect the vineyard from prey. He is your strength and your peace.
- •REWARD Harvest [Fruit] He receives a return on His investment. His name must be glorified.

As He prunes our lives, "the branches" we can bear much fruit and these fruits are eternal. Most times when we think of bearing fruit for God, we think of the ministries we do like evangelism, teaching bible studies, being a pastor, worship leader etc. However, the fruit that the Master Gardener prunes us to bear is "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, and self-control," (Galatians 5:22). These must precede the ministries that we do. Let the Master Gardener be the Gardener and you be the branch.

KEY SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 2:10 Amplified

READING: Ephesians 2:10; Psalm 139:13-16; Jeremiah 1:5

CHAPTER TWO: MY FATHER IS THE MASTER GARDENER

INTRODUCTION

For we are His workmanship [His own masterpiece, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn; spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the life which He prearranged and made ready for us]. Ephesians 2:10 Amplified

You were created on purpose, for a purpose! This means that a very intentional God created you in your mother's womb with a specific objective in mind. Not only did He have an objective in mind, but every one of your days were written down in His book before one of them came to be! (Psalm 139:13-16). God did not make a mistake when He created you. He considers your contribution and purpose extremely valuable and necessary to the advancement of His kingdom! Often, we have a hard time believing God has a purpose for our lives, because of our past, our background, our upbringing, the way we look, or our personality. Romans 8:28 [Amp] read; And we know [with great confidence] that God [who is deeply concerned about us] causes all things to work together [as a plan] for good for those who love God, to those who are called according to His

plan and purpose. Every part of your life has purpose. Even those times that were difficult. There are chapters in our lives that we would rather rewrite or delete completely. Even those times God can and will turn them around and use them for His glory! It is important to note that God does not author those times of hardship or pain, but He sees it, and when we hand it over to Him, He gives beauty for ashes. Personally, the very things that I despised about myself or my life growing up as a child have made me into the person that I am. God used all those situations to forged me into who I am. Even the things I wanted to change; God used to serve His purposes in my life!

So, be encouraged today that God created you with a seed of purpose on the inside of you. When you came to know Jesus, that purpose comes to life, and everything begins to make sense. Your contribution in life is just that—YOURS! Your perspective, your experience, your uniqueness, it's all for a purpose! So, embrace the fact that God is crazy about you. He believes in you, and He has a specific plan designed that only you are equipped to fulfill! You were created on purpose for a purpose. So, own it! In conclusion, below are 10 scriptures to prove you were born for a special purpose

1. He knitted you together before you came into this world

"I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made secret, and skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth". (Psalms 139:14-15)

2. He already loved you before He created you

"Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you; Before you were born, I sanctified you; I ordained (something special for you) you a prophet to the nations." (Jeremiah 1:5)

3. He wrote your destiny in His book: There is a record about You!

"Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be" (Psalms 139:16)

4. He has already devised a plan for your life

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11)

5. He already refers to you as being wonderfully made

"I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful; I know that full well". (Psalms 139:14)

6. He already knows your name even before it was decided

"I will do the very thing you have asked because I am pleased with you, and I know you by name". (Exodus 33:17)

7. No one can stop what He has in store for you

"Who is he who speaks, and it comes to pass, when the Lord has not commanded it"? (Lamentations 3:37)

8. He knows and has seen all your life's struggles

Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account. (Hebrews 4:13)

9. He is aware of what you are going through

For a man's ways are before the eyes of the Lord, and he ponders all his paths. (Proverbs 5:21)

10. He will always be with you for the rest of your life

I am your God and will take care of you until you are old, and your hair is gray. I made you and will care for you; I will give you help and rescue you. (Isaiah 46:4)

I encourage you to take a moment to reflect on what you just read. Every day you when you wake up in the morning thank God for His plans and purpose for your life. Be optimistic for a better tomorrow and know you were created with purpose and for a purpose. Do not think that your life is meaningless. You were created for a special reason, which is only known to the Most High God. You will live it out when you let Him be the Gardener of your life.

KEY SCRIPTURE: Psalm 139:3-5 TLB

READING: Psalm 139:3-5; Dan. 4:35; Proverbs 19:21 Amp. Col. 1:17

CHAPTER ONE: MY FATHER IS THE MASTER GARDENER

INTRODUCTION

You chart the path ahead of me and tell me where to stop and rest. Every moment you know where I am. You know what I am going to say before I even say it. You both precede and follow me and place your Hand of blessing on my head. Psalm 139:3-5 The Living Bible

God's providence refers to His wise and personal acts, whereby He creates and controls circumstances to direct history according to His predetermined plan, all for His glory and the benefit of His people. As Christians, we live in the flow of history, and are moved by the circumstances He controls, for the Lord "does according to His will in the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of earth; and no one can ward off His hand or say to Him, 'What have You done?'" (Dan. 4:35). Providence is normally defined in Christian theology as the unceasing activity of the Creator whereby, in overflowing bounty and goodwill (Ps. 145:9 cf. Mt. 5:45–48), He upholds His creatures in ordered existence (Acts 17:28; Col. 1:17; Heb. 1:3), guides and governs all events, circumstances and free acts of men and directs everything to its appointed goal, for His own glory (cf. Eph. 1:9–12).

We have far less control than we want to admit and far more freedom than we ever imagined. In conclusion, lets ponder over these three verses of scripture considering God's providence. Remember, the Gardener owns the vineyard, and He cares for every branch in His vineyard. He is at work in you and upholds and directs your life.

"Many plans are in a man's mind, but it is the Lord's purpose for him that will stand". Proverbs 19:21 Amp

"A man's heart plans his way, But the Lord directs his steps". Proverbs 16:9

"For it is [not your strength, but it is] God who is effectively at work in you, both to will and to work [that is, strengthening, energizing, and creating in you the longing and the ability to fulfill your purpose] for His good pleasure". Philippians 2:13 Amp

KEY SCRIPTURE: Luke 12:6-7

READING: Hebrews 4:13; Psalm 37:23-25; Psalm 139:1-6

CHAPTER ONE: MY FATHER IS THE MASTER GARDENER

INTRODUCITON

Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten by God. Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Luke 12:6-7

The Master Gardener is aware of every detail of your life. The scripture tells us that "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight" (Hebrews 4:13) and that God knows when I sit down and when I rise; You discern my thoughts from afar" (Psalm 139:1-6) He directs the steps of the godly and delights in every detail of their lives (Psalm 37:23-25). Consider how remarkable it is that God would even number the hairs on our head and keeps our tears in a bottle.

Some may think God does not care what happens to us. Sometimes, we feel we have fallen through the cracks and that the universe is so huge and we are so small, so why should God worry about me? God is too big to be interested in what happens to me, therefore I am on my own. When we believe that we are on our own, we begin to act as the master gardner of our own lives. That is far from the truth. God is interested in every seemingly trivial detail of our lives. If God is like us — limited, and only able to concentrate on a few things at a time, then

you may be right; He probably wouldn't care about us. After all, you and I can barely keep track of what's happening in our own lives, let alone what's happening to everyone else. However, God is not like that! We are limited, but He is not! We can't keep track of everything that's happening, but He can! You say God is "too big" to care about me, but that's the point. He is so great that He knows about even the smallest details of your life. The Bible says, "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give an account" (Hebrews 4:13). "God's sovereign control is complete, not partial. It governs every aspect of nature, history, and personal life." AW Tozer said, "All of life, down to the tying of shoelaces and the brushing of teeth, is directed by God."

Who Makes the Plans?

"The plans of the heart belong to man, but the answer of the tongue [this is what really happens] is from the Lord" (Proverbs 16:1).

"The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord [this is what really happens] establishes his steps" (Proverbs 16:9).

"Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the Lord that will stand" (Proverbs 19:21).

"A man's steps are from the Lord; how then can man understand His way?" (Proverbs 20:24).

"The works of His hands are faithful and just; all His precepts are trustworthy." (Psalm 111:7)

"Be my rock of refuge, to which I can always go; give the command to save me, for you are my rock and my fortress." (Psalm 71:3)

KEY SCRIPTURE: 1 John 4:16

READING:

CHAPTER ONE: MY FATHER IS THE MASTER GARDENER

INTRODUCTION

"And so, we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them". 1 John 4:16

John 15:9-10 reads, "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love".

What comes to mind when you hear the phrase "unconditional love"? Maybe unconditional love sounds like a wonderful, comforting thing. Or perhaps, when you hear those words together a part of you doubts that such a thing truly exists.

Imperfect Examples of Love

If I had to guess, all of us could probably think of a time where love came with conditions. You thought that person would stay forever, but then they left. A parent only praised you when you performed well in school, but then would become angry or disappointed when you failed. Your best friend stopped hanging out with you when they started a new relationship. You shared an area of weakness with someone at your church, but they respond with judgement instead of

empathy. Everyone's story is different, but at one time or another, someone we loved or trusted have let us down thus, causing us hurt and pain. And often, we project that on God and allow our painful experiences with people to shape our view of God's love for us. It is difficult for many to believe that God's love has no conditions, or no strings attached. If you can relate at all, here is the truth that I need you to hear today: **God loves you unconditionally**.

God's Perfect Love

God does not have love, **HE IS LOVE!** God's love is unwavering for you. Nothing you could do, say, or think can keep you from the love of God. The Lord is not worried about you being perfect. God will not leave you because you make a mistake or fail. His love for you is not determined by how often you pray or read your Bible. God loves you as you are right now in this moment more than He ever has, and nothing will ever change His love. 1 Corinthians 13: 4-7 describes characteristics of love:

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

In conclusion, let's reflect on these quotes on God's unfailing love!
