

HOME RUN DERBY RULES

MEN

Each Batter is responsible for providing their own pitcher

Batters will be grouped based on a random online generator

Groupings will be posted the day prior to the event – and will be visible at the field

Each batter will have 7 swings (not pitches) in a round to determine their home run count

The batter that has the highest number of home runs for their grouping will move to the final round

In the event of a tie in a grouping, there will be a (1-swing) “swing-off” tie-breaker for the batters tied

The furthest hit (landing spot) from the batters involved in the tie-breaker will determine who advances to the finals

The same rules apply for the final round.

WOMEN

Each Batter is responsible for providing their own pitcher

Cones will be placed in the field to designate areas where points can be earned

The Field Map shows the cone placement, as well as the point opportunities for each zone

A zone is represented by the area in-between the arcs of cones that flow from the left field foul line, around to the right field foul line

Points are awarded based on where the ball first lands, not where it finishes it's roll

Batters will be grouped based on a random online generator

Groupings will be posted the day prior to the event – and will be visible at the field

Each batter will have 7 swings (not pitches) in a round to determine their point count

The batter that has the highest number of points for their grouping will move to the final round

In the event of a tie in a grouping, there will be a (1) swing-off tie-breaker for the batters tied

The furthest hit from the batters involved in the tie-breaker will determine who advances to the finals

The same rules apply for the final round.
