The newsletter veteran story this month is about our military services comrade Ron Smith who served in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War. He was drafted and served as a Medical Corpsman to help wounded combat soldiers in hospitals and field medical centers. He worked closely with his veteran friends and comrades to patch and fix wounded soldiers on the battlefield, as well as providing appropriate medications to help combat soldiers recover. He worked closely with his comrades to repair physical injuries of combat soldiers for the recovery procedures, and to ensure they are well protected thereafter the recovery process. He selected the medical field because he wants to become a doctor thereafter his military services career.

His military experience was very helpful to learn more about life and becoming a better person in society. He is very proud of serving his country and feels very good about his military career, as well as making new veteran friends. He will do it again, and continue to serve his country if necessary and would help veterans in local communities with their families.
