
What will my child need for school?

Infants Classroom

- 4 Baby bottles (sent home daily)
- 4 Bibs (sent home daily)
- Diapers (enough for 1 week)
- Wet wipes
- At least 2 full pairs of extra clothes
- 2 crib sheets for the week
- Optional Snacks

Toddlers Classroom

- Sippy cup for water
- Diapers (enough for 1 week. 5 per day)
- Wet wipes
- At least 2 full pairs of extra clothes
- 1 Crib Sheet and a cotton blanket
- Optional Snacks



Two's Classroom

- Sippy cup or water bottle
- Diapers (enough for 1 week. 5 per day)
- Wet wipes
- At least 3 full pairs of extra clothes
- 1 Crib Sheet and a cotton blanket
- Optional Snacks
- If potty training: 1 pair of extra shoes, 2 pairs of socks.
- 3 pairs of underwear per day.

Preschoolers (3's and 4's)

- Sippy cup or water bottle
- At least 2 full pairs of extra clothes
- 1 Crib Sheet and a cotton blanket
- Optional Snacks

Pre-Kindergarteners (4's and 5"s) and VPK's

- Sippy cup or water bottle
- At least 2 full pairs of extra clothes
- 1 Crib Sheet and a cotton blanket (VPK only students do not nap at the center)
- Optional Snacks
- One 2" inches binder and 25 protector sheets
