The key document for identifying this man as the brother of James Patton Miller is the state of Tennessee death certificate #2481 (reg # 19, reg district #911), signed January 6, 1941. The immediate cause of death is listed on this record as uremia over a period of 13 days, related to the condition of chronic nephritis. The place of death is identified on this certificate as the Government Reservation at Mountain Home, Tennessee, specifically at the Veterans' Administration Hospital there. This document gives his name as George R. Miller, widowed. His birthplace is listed as North Carolina, city or county unknown. His parents are listed as Andrew B. Miller and Minerva Parham, both of North Carolina. The informant is identified as the VAF Hospital Records. His place of enlistment is given on the application for headstone (completed by VA staff) as Mt. Vernon, Alabama, and his service organization as the third U.S. Artillery. The enlistment and honorable discharge dates are given as 1 April 1882 and 31 March 1887. The place of discharge was Ft. McHenry MD. The application for headstone (apparently completed by the soldiers' home) also gives his pension number as 1 481 919. A separate brief military, domestic and home history has been found in the volume entitled "U.S. National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, 1866 - 1938." This record gives his height as 5 feet, 8 inches, his complexion as fair and his eye color as blue. His religion is given as protestant and his occupation as a preacher. His permanent residence (in 1932) is shown on the form as Ball Ground, Georgia, where his wife and family live. His wife's name is given on this form only as Mrs. George R. Miller.

Mr. Miller appers to have been one who liked to be on the move. Just when he left North Carolina is unsure. Perhaps he ran away from home to join the Army but he was barely 16 at the age of his enlistment based on the birth date of 7 Feb 1857 given on his death certificate. Still he lived a relatively long life-- 83 years, 10 months, and 28 days-- according to the death record.

When George married Adra Willocks in 1897, he was 40 and she only 16. How and where they met is unknown. One of the most curious things about this connection is the state of Tennessee marriage record which gives his name as George Martin. The 1900 federal census shows George and Adra Martin living in the Choctaw Nation of Indian Territory (Oklahoma) with two sons-- Robert born in Tennessee in Aug 1898 or 1899 (unclear) and Roy born in Oklahoma in May 1900. By 1920 George and Adra have ten children and are living in the Clayton district of Cherokee County Georgia. He is listed as George R. Miller (age 64, born in North Carolina). Adra is 39 (born in TN) and thier chirdren (with ages and birth states) are: Robert S. (21, TN), George R. (19, OK), Ethel (17, AR), Ella (14, TN), Altha (11, TN), Ora (10, TN), Virgil C. (8, TN), Enoch C. (6, GA), Jewel (2yr, 5 mo, GA), and Bonnie (infant). It might seem that the marriage record listing Mr. Miller's name as George Martin

was simply a recording mistake. However, there are two other quite interesting things to consider. First, in the handwritten mariage record: E. L. Williamson, J.P. was crossed out and written in it's place in the same handwriting is S. T. Willocks, M.G. (Was this the Adra's father or another relative authorizing the marriage because she was so young?) Another very curious thing is that the family is first found in the federal census records living in Blount County, TN (where the marriage took place) but listed under the name George W. Martin. In spite of the last name (Martin rather than Miller) all of the children's names match those of the 1920 census and the ages of all family members (including George and Adra) are correct. One wonders if it was Mr. Miller's full intention to change his name. Whatever he intended, by the time he needed the services of a veteran's hospital, he no doubt had to use the name under which he enlisted in order to qualify for benefits. In fact, access to VA health care may have been part of the reason for the family relocating from Tennessee to Georgia, although there is no direct evidence to support this suggestion.

Another interesting question is whether Mr. Miller had previously been married and perhaps even had children by a prior marriage. This issue has not yet been carefully researched but remains a distinct possibility. One bit of evidence in support of this idea is reference found on the internet to a 1934 article appearing in the Atlanta Journal charging Manson Miller in the death of his half sister Ethel (Miller) Cook, one of the children of George and Adra.

Adra was relatively young (47) at the time of her death in 1928. At least one of the Miller children preceded her in death: Virgil died in 1927. One of the children (Ora May) was about 16 at the time and became employed at the veterans home near Johnson City as a waitress. The 1930 US census records show that the three youngest children were taken in by older siblings. Enoch Cicero (age 14 at the time of his mother's death) went to live with Robert and his wife Martha in Miami Shores, Dade County, Florida, Jewell (age 10 or 11 in 1928), went to live with her brother Roy (George R. in the 1910 and 1920 census records) in the town of Madison, Morgan County, Georgia, and the youngest Bonnie was taken in by her older sister Altha and Husband William Cox who lived in Townsend, Pickens County, Georgia.
