 - b) Director Longhi has requested that a speed bump be installed on Grant Woods Pkwy on the hill above his driveway to discourage speeding by folks to and from the Southern Properties.
 - c) April 1, 2021 Firewise Committee is proposing community work party to prune back lower branches of the Desert Willow trees at the hairpin turn and the entry way. Trimming the tree branches back to about 8 ft. will reduce the likelihood that a fire on the ground will use the branches as a ladder to move to tree crowns.
