

Guidelines for Construction within Arrowhead Shores No Construction may commence prior to Architectural Control Committee (ACC) approval.

- Property Boundaries must be clearly marked.
 - It is highly recommended that a property survey be completed and included with your application.
 - ➤ Having your property boundary markers in place will help with all ACC transactions and clear up confusion for the owner and neighbors.
- NO structure may be placed or constructed closer than 10 feet from the front boundary of the property.
- **Easements** are reserved at the sides and rear of most lots *(review deed restrictions carefully*).
 - 5-foot utility easement on both sides of each lot.
 - 5-foot utility easement at the rear of each lot.
- ❖ All septic approval must be complete an approved by the ACC prior to the start of installation.
- ❖ All septic permits come from the Hood County Health Department.

Tyou must follow their guidelines.

Septic Systems must be approved to accommodate the specific size (sq. Footage) of the residence constructed.

- ❖ All construction MUST COMPLY with the **Building Code for the State of Texas.**
- ❖ All building materials <u>MUST BE NEW</u>.

NO previously used materials are allowed without special approval from the ACC. See the Deed Restrictions for use or non-use of certain used exterior materials.

- ❖ Provide a dimensioned plat or layout of your property which locates the placement of any structures and septic (tank and lateral field).
- Provide as much construction detail as possible (plans, building materials list, contractor names if you are not the General Constructor).
- After ACC approval you have 6 months to start your construction and then 8 months to complete the project as to the exterior finish. You must provide an estimated start date to the ACC.
- ❖ You may be allowed to have a travel trailer as temporary living during the construction of your dwelling. See the Deed Restrictions for more detail and complete the temporary use form.
- ❖ If any questions arise during the completion of your project please contact the ACC. Specifically, if you will not be able to complete your construction on schedule.
- Maintain a neat appearance of your construction site during construction phase.
 Disposal of waste in a timely manner mandatory and greatly appreciated by your neighbors.
