These examples I just want to use as examples that exemplify contrast of what is, in effect, the same "color"... *and is definitely not the same color*. The non-metal metal gold in the upper left is highlights and shadows to varying degrees - contrast within a section of the model. The glowing axe glyphs... the fire at the base of the AoS knight... even the tattoos on the guy to the right. Individual colors have contrast within them making it distinct and pleasing to the eye.
