

More examples of things you can likely achieve just as well as I did. Some cheating with metallics... Green Stuff World's Color Shift paints (used on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Ed elves to the right, Willy Wood Elves below, and Miggz' squig) take light differently depending on viewing angle and will give you different colors – *kind of cheating and giving you contrast within the tone with just the one layer*. My Cittàgazze Ballhawks, to the right, just were sprayed with the Color Shift, then flesh tone, shadow, highlight. Gold accoutrement, and rainbow hair. Simple dynamic contrast.

When looking at other people's models, notice how the better the contrast, the more eye catching their work is.
