### **What is an IEE?**

An Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE) is a comprehensive assessment conducted by a qualified professional outside of your child's school. It provides a second opinion when you have concerns about the school's evaluation.

### **Families often seek an IEE when:**

- They disagree with a school evaluation
- They feel something is being missed
- They want a deeper understanding of their child's needs

### **When Can I Request an IEE?**

You have the right to request an IEE **if you disagree with the school's evaluation.**

You do NOT need to prove why

You do NOT need a lawyer

You simply need to state that you disagree

## **Who Pays for the IEE?**

When you request an IEE, the school must:

Fund the IEE

OR

File for due process to show their evaluation was appropriate

## **Why an IEE Matters**

A strong, independent evaluation can:

- Identify missed diagnoses
- Provide deeper insight into your child's needs
- Strengthen IEP supports and services
- Help you advocate with clarity and confidence

## **Signs You May Want an IEE**

You might consider requesting an IEE if:

- The evaluation felt rushed
- Important areas weren't assessed (like executive functioning)
- The results don't match what you see at home
- Recommendations feel limited or unclear
