











Dopamine


Helps Concentrate; Random Bursts; Easily Lost


Most Students Use It for Non Class Related Purposes

Have Laptops Open Even if There is No Need






When It Comes to Local Students

Do External Factors Bother You?


80% said They Dislike The Administration and The Only Positive Thing Are Their friends



100% Students Said They Feel Homesick 70% Said The Campus's Quality of Student Life is Degrading Every Semester




100% Students Said The Financial Policy Changes Bother Them a Lot




For International Students

- They are distracted in class by such issues and find it hard to focus








Worried About Affording Food 60%


Frustration and Communication Error

100% Students Said "Why should I Take These Classes




80% Students Said it Stops Them From Taking Preferred Classes




