Some biblical passages are **open to various interpretations, and the lack of clear definitive answers** to every detail of prophecy can lead to **differing views.**

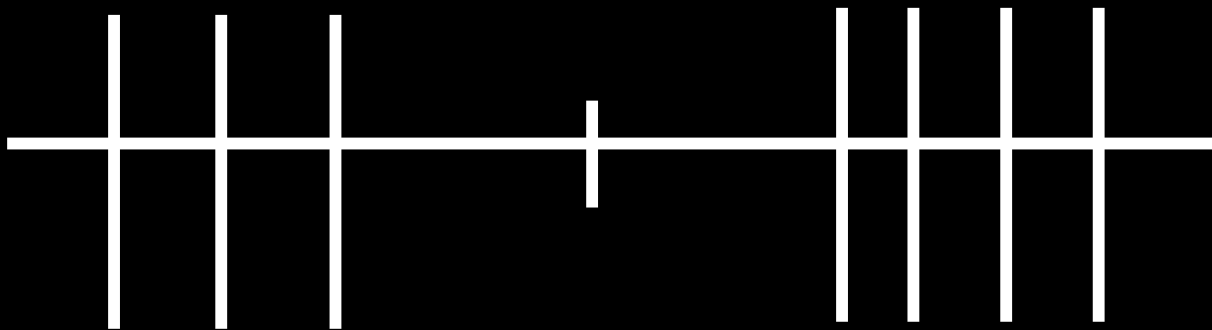
Despite the disagreements, most Christian viewpoints agree **that Christ will one day return and that God's kingdom will be fulfilled.**

- Church Age (the “current” place for teaching/training/preparing believers)
- Rapture (God “snatching” the church before his wrath)
- Great Tribulation (a period of intense suffering for those left behind)
- Second Coming (Jesus returning to earth for humanity)
- 1000 Year Reign (period where God will reign with his followers on earth)
- Final Judgement (the end where all humanity will be judged)
- Eternal State (the permanent, final, unchanging state of man)

- Jesus is coming back (Matthew 24:30-31/John 14:1-6)
- Let no one deceive you (Matthew 24:4)

7 BOOKS THAT DESCRIBE END TIME PROPHECY

- **Revelation:** describes the final warning, the great tribulation, the second coming; the final state.
- **Daniel:** describes future events, the antichrist; the breakdown of the 7 years of the great tribulation.
- **Matthew:** Jesus describes signs of the Second Coming, such as wars, famines, earthquakes, and the abomination of desolation.
- **2 Peter:** describes the Day of the Lord; Second Coming and the time of wrath
- **Isaiah:** This book contains prophecies about the first coming of Jesus, the Second Coming, the Antichrist, and signs in the heavens.
- **1 Thessalonians :** describes the Rapture and details for the dead in Christ.
- **Acts:** describes Jesus ascension and ultimately how he will return.
