


YOUNGBLOOD #1

A few years ago, my Dad showed me the first issue of the first volume of *Youngblood* (from 1992). To me that issue was awesome, the colors that pop straight off the page, the classic 90's line work, and Rob Liefeld's pencils. Now, about 30 years since the release of that book, it's been rebooted. This comic is a great way to reboot a series that some people may have forgotten about. It drops you right in the beginning of a fight while introducing each character and showing off their abilities – the perfect little refresher. The art in this issue showcases that classic Liefeld–look while incorporating modern colors and techniques. Reading this comic I felt about the same amount of awe and admiration as I felt reading that very first issue from 1992. My final ranking out of ten would be a **8.7/10.**

Wow. This movie was fantastic, also my introduction to Guillermo Del Toro's style. The things that stood out to me most were the cinematography and the costume/set design. The colors really reflected the vibe of each character and the mood of the scene, making the important parts of the film all the more impactful. The challenge is to combine two or more of your favorite heroes, villains, or characters into one "Super-Stein" character. Make it as creepy or cheesy as you'd like!


