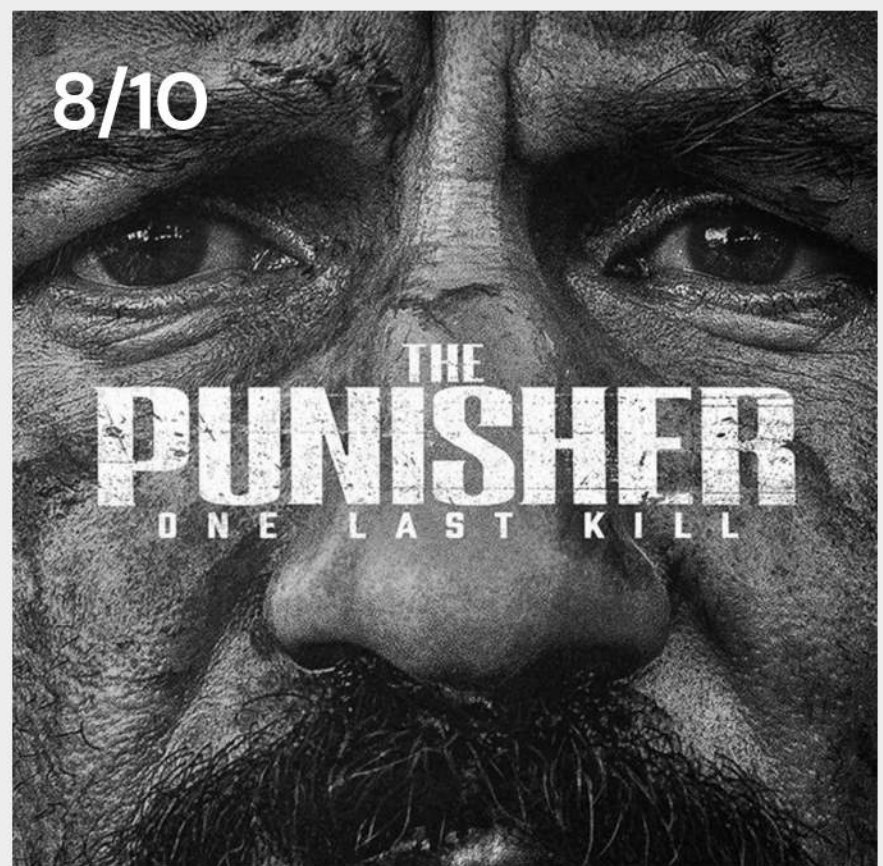
### DEAR BERNADETTE

### BAD BOYS

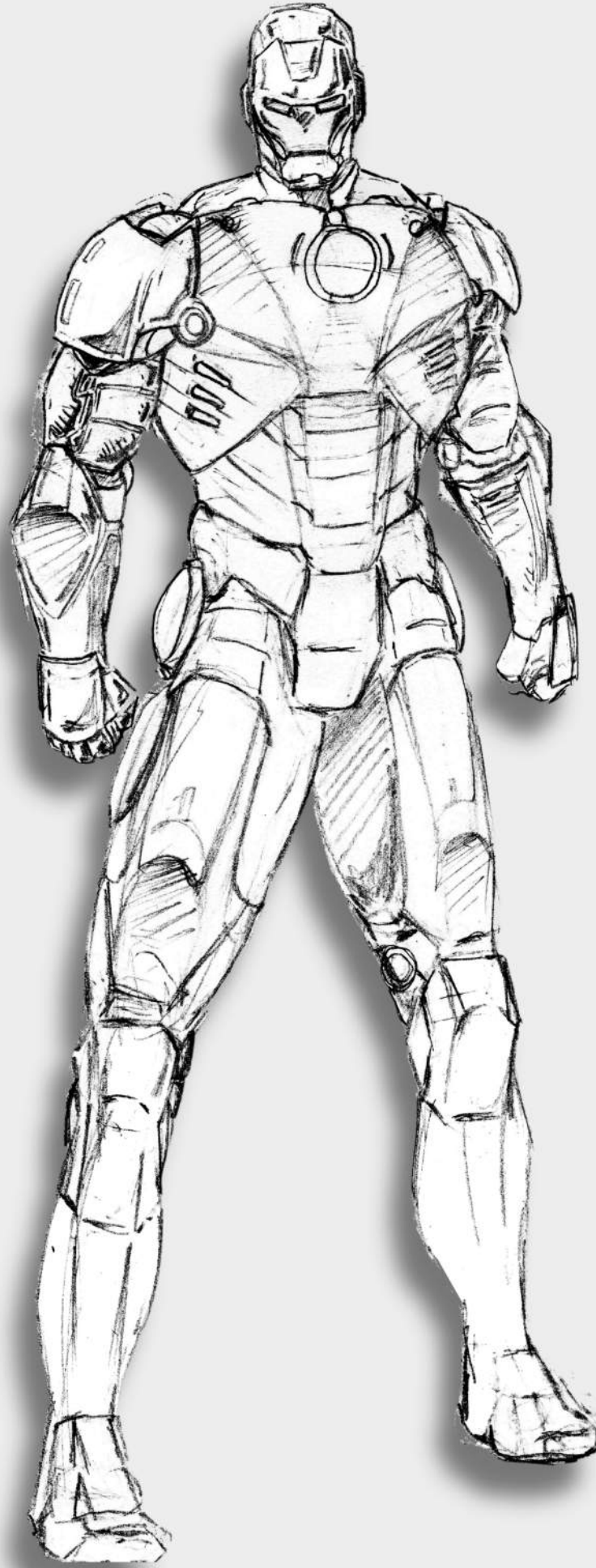
