
Arise to Freedom Support Group meets every other Monday

Our Founders story

Ms. Keisha G. McCroskey was born to a teen mom. Which lead her to be in the foster care system until she went to live with her abusive grandmother. While staying with her family, Keisha experienced mental abuse; she was raped at ten. She was sex-trafficked at twelve, and she dropped out of school in the ninth grade.

Ms. Keisha ended up getting married at twenty-three and having a son. While being married, she endured being physically, mentally, and sexually abused for eight years. Abusing drugs for seventeen years and hustling for ten years, she became homeless and lost everything she owned. These life-changing moments prompted Keisha to become a Christian, earn her H.S. diploma, and dreams of becoming a successful businesswoman.

In 2017 Keisha founded Seeds for Growth And Development, Inc because of her love for humanity and civic duty. Currently, she is the Founder/CEO, and chairwoman at SFGAD, Inc. Keisha has over 20 years of business management experience in the social service and entertainment industry. She has organized benefit concerts such as the Save Our Youth Rally, Peace, and Unity 2nd annual event in 2016.
