This lesson is inspired by Pablo Picasso. This is a fun way to play with colors and basic shapes such as circle, triangle and square or which ever shape you want to make.

What to use?

PAPER OR CANVAS

PENCIL

WATER COLOR OR ACRYLICS

PAINT BRUSH

Instructions

1. WITH THE PENCIL DRAW ON THE PAPER THE HEAD SHAPE FIRST, THEN THE NOSE, EYES, MOUTH, HAIR, AND EARS. YOU CAN ALSO ADD ANY FEATURE THAT YOU LIKE. MAYBE THE PERSON HAS GLASSES, EARRINGS, MUSTACHE, ETC.

2.ONCE YOU HAVE THE BASIC PORTRAIT DONE YOU MAY ADD PATTERNS, SUCH AS STRIPES, POLKA-DOTS ETC.

3. YOU ARE NOW READY TO FILL IN THE SHAPES. USE PRIMARY COLORS (RED, BLUE, AND YELLOW) OR ANY BRIGHT COLOR YOU LIKE. **TIP:** DON'T COLOR SHAPES THAT ARE NEXT TO EACH OTHER THE SAME COLOR.
