What to use?

PAPER OR CANVAS
PENCIL

WATER COLOR OR ACRYLICS
OR CRAYONS
PAINT BRUSH

Instructions

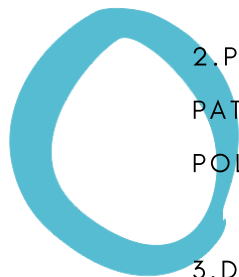
1.START WITH A PAPER AND PENCIL AND DRAW THE OUTLINE SHAPES OF THE CUPCAKE.

2.PAPER CUP: DRAW A SQUARE, YOU MAY ADD PATTERNS INSIDE THE SHAPE SUCH AS STRIPES OR POLKA-DOTS.

3.DRAW THE ICING BY STACKING HORIZONTAL RINGLETS MAKING THEM SMALLER AS YOU MOVE UP TOWARDS THE TOP.

4.DECORATION: ADD LITTLE SPRINKLES AND CHERRY ON TOP. FILL IN WITH FUN AND YUMMY COLORS.
