

# Blue Dog

## LESSONS 3

This lesson is inspired by George Rodrigue. He is famous for painting the "blue dog". In this session you are going to make one of your own. His paintings normally depict a blue dog in different surrounding elements.  
I.E. Blue dog in a flower field, at a circus, at a school, etc.

### Instructions

1. LET YOUR IMAGINATION LOOSE. NOTE: WE WILL MOSTLY BE USING OUR BASIC SHAPES SUCH AS CIRCLES AND TRIANGLES.
2. DRAW THE DOG:
  - HEAD: DRAW A CIRCLE
  - EARS: DRAW TWO TRIANGLES
  - SNOUT: DRAW CIRCLE WITH 2 NOSTRILS.
  - EYES: DRAW TWO CIRCLES, ONE FOR EACH EYE, AND TWO SMALLER CIRCLES TO REPRESENT THE PUPILS
  - LEGS: DRAW THE FRONT PAWS AND BACK PAWS.
3. FUN TIP: ADD A HAT OR CROWN TO THE DOG.
4. BACKGROUND: IMAGINE A SCENERY FOR THE DOG TO BE. I.E. STRAWBERRY FIELD, THE MOON, AT THE PARK.
5. FILL IN THE SHAPES WITH COLORS OF YOUR CHOICE.

### What to use?

PAPER OR CANVAS  
PENCIL  
WATER COLOR OR ACRYLICS  
OR CRAYONS  
PAINT BRUSH
