This lesson is inspired by Jackson Pollock. He is famous for his action painting, also known as splatter painting. He used his brush, sticks or other random objects to create massive paintings filled with drips & splatters.

Instructions

1. YOU MIGHT WANT TO DO THIS OUTSIDE TO ELIMINATE THE MESS INSIDE.
2. UTILIZE A DARK BACKGROUND, IE. BLACK PAPER YOU CAN ALSO DO THIS ON WHITE PAPER AS WELL.
3. ADD A LITTLE WATER TO BRUSH AND ADD PAINT FLICK THE BRUSH WITH A DOWNWARD MOTION SO PAINT SPLATTERS ONTO PAGE.
4. USE VARIOUS COLORS. USE THE HANDLE (OPPOSITE) SIDE OF BRUSH AND DRAG IT THROUGH THE WET PAINT CREATING LINES.
5. HAVE FUN & CLEAN UP WELL :)
