



Chiefland Watermelon Pageant COVID-19 Terms and Conditions

The following terms and guidelines are MANDATORY for ALL contestants and their guest in order to participate in the 2021 Chiefland Watermelon Pageant.

The annual Chiefland Watermelon Festival Pageant will be held on
May 29th, 2021

Where: Chiefland Elementary School from 1:00PM to 4:00 PM

No General Admission attendance will be permitted.

Due to COVID-19, there will be NO rehearsal prior to the pageant. Please practice a beauty walk of your choice at home as well as answering a question before exiting the stage. Contestants will enter from the back of the stage area, complete a beauty walk to the left of the stage, answer their on-stage question and exit down the front left steps where they will remain lined up for a final group look.

In light of COVID-19, the following terms and conditions MUST be followed:

1. Masks are REQUIRED to be worn by ALL in attendance and must be worn for the duration of time you are onsite. Contestants will be allowed to remove their mask for their stage presentation only.
2. No more than 30 people are allowed in the building at a time.
3. Age groups will be broken down by times. Please remain in your vehicle prior to entry. You may enter no more than 10 minutes before your scheduled stage time.
4. There are no changing rooms, please come ready and dressed in your stage attire.
5. Guests attending are asked to sit in small groups at least 6 feet apart. Masks are REQUIRED to enter the building and must be worn the entire time you are onsite.
6. Guests are limited to 3 per contestant.
7. NO food or drinks will be permitted inside the building.
8. Guests may take photos and videos of contestants while on stage but must remain at least 6 feet away from the judge's table.
9. For the health and safety of others, anyone unwilling to follow these terms and conditions will be denied entry and or required to leave the premises.
