

# Name the three different types of game reports and the purpose of each.



AT6	AT6 – Unsportsmanlike Conduct Report Form	
	Report unsportsmanlike conduct of a student, coach, or schoorepresentative.	



Report miscellaneous situations: facilities issues, event cancellation, injuries, spectator misconduct, equipment/uniform compliance issues, or any other incident not previously mentioned.

#### AT7 – Exceptional Sportsmanship Report

A coach, student-athlete, team, official, spectator(s) or school in general has done an exemplary job of displaying sportsmanship.


# What are the correct steps to submitting an AT6?



- Confirm incident details with crew before leaving the venue. If bench emptying brawl or terminated match, immediately call (352)372-9551 ext. 260 (once safe). Text Scott and John Brockman notifying of send-off/situation: Scott 985-259-0652 John 850-454-4038 "Ejected EHS Coach Del Greatwood for Abusive Language." Draft game report details and email to Scott and Mike Walter. President@PensacolaSoccerRefereesAssociation.org MWalter2001@cox.net
  - Make any requested changes/corrections.
- Submit AT6 to FHSAA must be done within 24 hours.


## Locating and submitting the official AT6.

Open ArbiterSports and Login. Switch to FHSAA Central Hub. Click "Ejection Report" Enter Password "123" Click "Ejection" Enter event information then click "Save & Next" Enter offender's info and incident details then click "Save & Next" Enter official's information then click "Submit"



## Locating and submitting the official AT6 Misc.

- Open ArbiterSports and Login.
- Switch to FHSAA Central Hub.
- Click "Ejection Report"
- Enter Password "123"
- Click "Incident"
- Enter incident information then click "Save & Next"



# GENERAL REPORT WITH STATES

#### Report writing 101:



- Include only the facts Eliminate opinion, speculation, or disciplinary suggestions Make it short and simple Use current and appropriate terminology based on NFHS/FHSAA Rules Include time, location, participants, and factual description of incident Include any further issues or disciplinary actions related to the incident e.g.: failure to leave the field timely, abusive language, etc. Include estimate of time delayed and type and location of restart
- Include general description of injury (if applicable) "complained of right knee pain" or "was evaluated for head injury"
- Include result of injury (if applicable) "returned to play in the \_ min," "did not return to the match," or "left the venue in an ambulance."

#### Specific Situations:



- DOGSO address all four considerations:
  - Distance to goal
  - Direction of play
  - Number and location of defenders
  - Likelihood of keeping control of ball
- Second Yellow Card mention the first caution
- Abusive Language state exactly what was said, do not use \*\*\*
- Striking specify mode, location of contact, and severity of contact
  - Open hand or closed fist?
  - Were they challenging for the ball?
  - Contact to the head or neck area?
