 - Rule 3-3-2c: Substitutions can occur when a game is temporarily suspended
 - Rule 3-3-2b2: ALL players including goalkeepers must be substituted when health care official or bench personnel are beckoned on the field to attend to the injured player
 - Rule 4-1-2: Numbers may be placed on the front of the jersey and/or shorts in addition to the back of the jersey
 - Rule 7-2-4: ONLY the team CAPTAINS can approach the referee team between periods unless beckoned by the referee
 - Misconduct Rule 12-4-4b: The head coach may be warned, cautioned or ejected for bench personnel misconduct. Referees may caution both bench personnel AND head coach for misconduct.
 - Rule 18 Definitions have been incorporated into pertinent rules.
