On Saturday, April 24th we descended upon the park to clear and tidy a few years worth of fallen leaves; sticks too big for play fighting; grass, leaves and garbage. Numerous families with bumps and little tots to teenagers and beyond sacrificed their time to brave an early wake up call to present the newly developed park in all its glory – if you haven't visited it, you must!

There were likely close to 200 bags next to the signage at the front of the park – I have the post-wheelbarrowing-ache to prove it – and the park AND entrance area really were overdue some love and attention following the winter.

As a new-ish member of the community it was an opportunity to say hello's to new neighbors; put faces to names of those I had heard of and then to re-connect with familiar faces hidden in winter gear over winter.
