




VIRGIL ABLOH

Virgil Abloh (1980-2021) was an American artist, architect, engineer, creative director, artistic director, industrial designer, fashion designer, musician, DJ and philanthropist. Considered one of the most influential and respected designers of his generation, he began his career working in streetwear fashion, founded the Milan-based label Off-White™, worked as the Creative Director of Kanye West's creative agency Donda, and became the first African-American Men's Artistic Director of a French luxury fashion house when he joined Louis Vulton. The New York Times described Abloh's design aesthetic as "transformative", and he was named as one of the "100 most influential people in the world' by Times magazine.

RICHARD SAPPER

Richard Sapper (1932-2015) was a German industrial designer based in Milan, Italy. He is considered one of the most important designers of his generation, his products typically featuring a combination of technical innovation, simplicity of form and an element of wit and surprise. He received numerous international design awards, including 11 Compasso d'Oro awards, and his designs are held in many museums around the world.

Kettle in stainless steel mirror polished with melodic whistle in brass and handle in PA, black. Magnetic steel heat diffusing bottom. This kettle was our first designer kettle, heralding a new season of kettle ideas for ourselves as well as many other kettle manufacturers. The true heart of this design is the brass whistle whose pipes sing two notes, mi and si, when the steam blows through them, giving a particularly attractive melody. Sapper wanted to avoid giving the kettles whistle the usual irksome sound of the other kettles on the market. And this purely musical requirement led to what I think can be described as Alessis first multi-sensorial design. This object appeared in the movies: Generazione 1000 euro (Generazione 1000 euro, M. Venier, 2008); Niente da nascondere (Caché, M. Haneke, 2005).

Bulbul is a perfect induction hob kettle imagined in the rounded shape of a curling stone: it presents a new way of handling this object, almost as if to suggest an invitation to play by sliding it across the kitchen surface. Bulbul reveals Achille Castiglioni's extraordinary ability to transfer qualities and functions into a project from objects belonging to entirely different spheres. This game of transfers has often resulted in the equally famous ironic dimension of many of his works.

ACHILLE CASTIGLIONI

Achille Castiglioni (1918-2002) was an Italian architect, designer and professor of design. He designed with an unmistakable blend of simplicity, irony and fun, with a close interest in the way objects are used and the potential offered by the use of technology and new materials. Considered one of the great masters of Italian design, he was a founding member of ADI in the 1950's. Throughout his lifetime, Castiglioni received many awards and distinctions for his designs, including 8 Compasso d'Oro awards as well as the Compasso d'Oro Career Award. His designs are held in museum collections around the world.

ALDO ROSSI

Aldo Rossi (1931-1997) was an internationally recognized and influential architect and designer, and was one of the leading proponents of the postmodern movement. He was the first Italian to receive the Pritzker Prize for architecture in 1990, and is considered by many to be the greatest Italian architect of the second half of the 20th century. An author of abstraction, reduction and brevitas, his severe language of primary shapes, geometrical patterns and silent evocation created some of the most intensely poetic works of architecture and design in his age. Ada Louise Huxtable, architectural critic and Pritzker juror, has described Rossi as "a poet who happens to be an architect."

Pito is a stainless steel kettle designed by Frank Gehry. The melodic top and the handle in mahogany have the stylized shape of two darting fishes. The melody produced by the whistle is likewise peculiar, it sounds like a whale's song. Gehry turned a kitchen tool into a fascinating poetic object.

Frank Gehry is a Canadian-born American architect and designer whose works are considered among the most important of contemporary architecture. With his earliest educational influences rooted in modernism, Gehry's work reflects a spirit of experimentation and is said to defy categorization. Awarded the Pritzker Architecture Prize, a number of his buildings have become world-renowned attractions leading Vanity Fair to call him "the most important architect of our age".
