April 15, 2024. The contest entries were reviewed and scored by seven LSA members. There were seven scoring areas with a maximum total of 50 points available:

1. GPA / QPA – 5 points
2. Honors & Awards – 5 points
3. School, Community Activities & Employment – 5 points
4. Hobbies – 5 points
5. Essay – 20 points
6. Overall Assessment – 10 points

As in past years, there was representation from many local high schools with the entrants planning on attending college or a trade school. There was a good mix of students vying to win a portion of the \$6,000 dollars offered by the LSA for the families of our members attending college or trade schools after high school graduation.

This year's winner of the top prize of \$2,000 is Cassidy Griffith. She had a top average score of over 45 points. She hails from Peters Township high School and plans to major in Biochemistry. She has yet to commit to college but has multiple acceptances.
