6) Roundtable

a) Bruce:

- i) proposed water & wastewater increase.
- ii) Illegal food vendors (tacos, hot dogs, etc.). PD has had training, but it is a lot of work for them to haul away the things, so they are not interested in enforcing. The county advises people to avoid eating at these places, since they have not been inspected by the health dept and don't have access to proper cleaning protocols. Send a letter to PD, or submit a "get it done" report to let the city know you are concerned.
- iii) Dumpster Day: Broadway Heights (off Mallard St), Sept 27 from 9-11
- iv) Bruce has access to free turkeys if anyone is in need closer to Thanksgiving time. Let him know.
- v) Trash cans on Federal: residents would need to vote & pay for cans and for maintenance/emptying of the cans.
 - (1) Can the Diamond Business Association sponsor the trash cans? Potentially, yes. Bruce will find out when their meetings are and let us know so someone can attend.
