  - Joe - logo update: Signtech created 2 possible logo ideas as a starting point, they will take feedback and update the logo if we want them. Signtech is also willing to help out with other projects needed. Joe also showed some AI logo options. People offered feedback on the logos. Joe will send feedback to SignTech and ask for updates.
    - Suggestions:
      - different fonts for easier printing (sizing)
      - Left logo (3 houses with flowers): Remove flowers on left logo and replace with trees
      - Right Logo (colored houses): Put "Friends of Webster" on top and neighbors building community underneath
    - Vote: left logo (3 houses with flowers) -15, Right logo (colored houses) - 3

- Ozzy - Webster Green Alley update - on Marilou and 48th/49th. Currently it is dirt and weeds, Groundwork is working on turning this into a green alley, with permeable pavers, plants, etc. Groundwork met with community members in a popup at Joehns to gather feedback. Groundwork also met with Cielo Cruz and an architect to work on design ideas. This is a starting project, so they are hoping this will be able to continue in other areas. Next step is a community meeting, for 60-90 minutes, where people can share ideas.
  - Where to hold event: in the potential green alley at 49th st
  - Time: Sunday, June 8, 2:00pm
  - Include: small clean up of alley during the event
    - Bring: trash bags, pickers (ask Canyonlands if they have any)
  - Kristen will talk to neighbors about the alley project and ask them to talk to their neighbors, to let them know what is happening.
  - Idea: open the kindergarten area of Webster to have a water/cooling station under the trees.
