

- Flashing beacon project on Federal at 48th: It is on the CIP list. Members discussed getting an update on the timeline for this project.
- Rite Aid (Old Big Lots) parking lot: John wants Friends of Webster to send an email to the owners of the lot regarding Low Rider events taking over the whole parking lot.
