## IN MEMORY OF SEAN 'DINGLE' DALY

Sean 'Dingle' Daly was a devoted and deeply respected figure within Armagh City Football Club. Joining the club in the late 1960s/early 1970s, he went on to make almost 300 appearances, scoring 65 goals. Remarkably, despite playing in midfield, he finished as the club's top scorer for three consecutive seasons between 1975 and 1979.

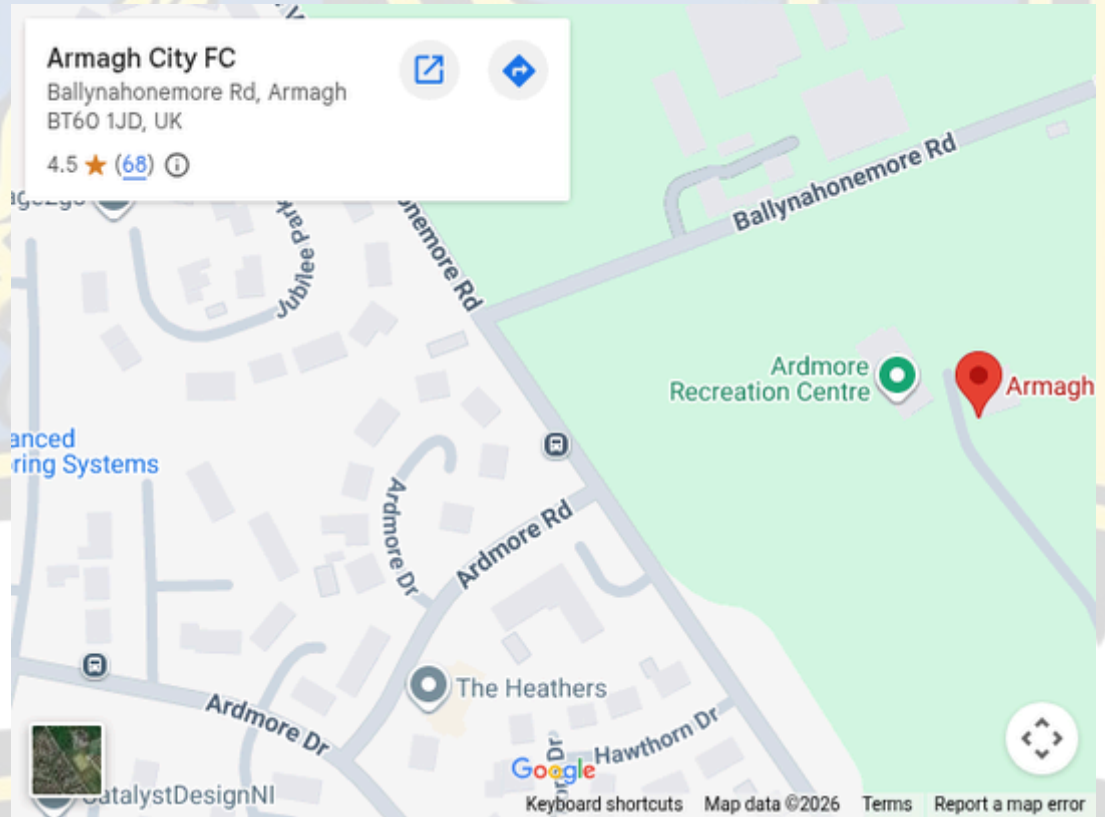
Sean later took on the role of joint first-team manager from 1982 to 1983, and from 2000 onwards he played a pivotal part in nurturing youth football at the club. His dedication and service were formally recognised when he was awarded Clubman of the Year in the 2013-2014 season.

Following his passing in January 2023, Sean is remembered with great affection by all who knew him. The seated stand at Holm Park, along with this festival, proudly celebrates his lasting legacy. Through his coaching, guidance, and commitment, Sean inspired generations within Armagh City Football Club, leaving a legacy that continues to shape the club today.

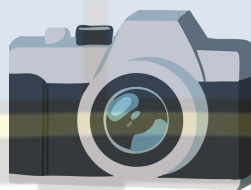
