WHAT WE DO

EMPLOYMENT PREPARATION

A Job Developer works with you during in-person and virtual meetings. We help sharpen skills: how to interview, job seek, network, and creating the perfect elevator pitch. By the end of these sessions, you will be a motivated and confident job seeker, ready to start applications with a positive outlook and a specific focus.

JOB PLACEMENT

We will spend time gathering leads and applying for jobs both in-person and online. We begin completing applications and support you in preparing for interviews. After applications are out, we teach you how to follow up with employers until you have landed a job.

JOB RETENTION

We will continue to meet on a weekly or monthly basis (depending on what you need) to ensure that everything is satisfactory with their new role. After three months of gainful employment, you will have successfully completed our program.

SHORT TERM SUPPORT

Some individuals need a little extra support in adjusting to their new role. We will have your job developer spend time with you on your job to ensure you are supported.
