

The Sallos Circuit: Emotional Interference Oracle

Lay Explanation

This circuit is like a magical link between hearts. It doesn't force or control--it opens both sides, lets them spin freely,
then gently connects them. Instead of certainty, it creates longing. Sallos doesn't bind--he entangles softly, like a warm glance.

Explanation for Children

Imagine you and your friend each blow a bubble. The bubbles float, dancing, then touch and join in the air.
They don't pop--they just shimmer together. That's what this circuit does. It helps two things meet and feel each other gently.

Explanation for Scientists

The Sallos Circuit begins with Hadamard gates on both qubits, establishing balanced superposition. A soft $R_z(\pi/8)$ is applied to qubit 0 and $R_y(\pi/4)$ to qubit 1, introducing phase and amplitude nuance. CNOT(01) lightly entangles the system, followed by a Z gate on qubit 0 to encode symbolic tension inversion.

Measurement reveals dominant outcomes in states $|01\rangle$ and $|10\rangle$, indicating resonant but asymmetric entanglement.

This behavior mimics attraction-interference structures, where unity emerges from balanced distinction.
