Valuable Tips: Early Membership & Renewal by July

One good tip is to start your membership drive early, aim to recruit one new member every month. By doing so, the last three to four months of the term will be a time of celebrations instead of concerns. Another valuable tip is to opt for early membership renewal, which will certainly make planning easier and less disruptive.

The early bird catches the worm. Members that renew their October 2023 to March 2024 with their club by 31 July 2023 will save US\$15.

And clubs that renew at least 8 members for 2 renewal periods* early will get "Early Bird" tokens such as the exclusive Club Officer Pins. Area Directors and Division Directors will also enjoy special awards.

*Renew Sept 2023 to March 2024 period in July 2023; and renew April - Sept 2024 period by Sept 2023.
