6. What emotions came up for you while reading?
7. What do you think happens to the souls after the Reaper guides them away?
8. Was there a story you wished was longer? Which one?
9. Did you find any comfort in the way the Reaper is portrayed in this book?
10. If you could sit with the Reaper for five minutes, what would you ask?

Optional Reflections (for group journaling or solo thought)

11. Write a short letter to the Reaper.
12. Describe your own idea of a 'final moment.'
13. Pick one story and write what could have happened next for the soul.
14. Which story felt like it was written for you? Why?
