- Applicants who are professionals or practising advocates shall be preferred, however we shall also be accepting applications by students with substantial experience in the field.
- Applicant must also be proficient in common citation styles.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct editing tasks such as content editing of research papers, articles, commentaries, etc.
- Give personalised comments for each manuscript reviewed.
- Take primary decisions on the basis of merits of a written piece.
- Related miscellaneous editorial assignments.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Interested candidates are required to send their applications along with your resume and Statement of Purpose (300-500 words) to editor@corpusjuris.co.in, with the subject line **“Application for the Position of a Reviewer”**. After the initial scrutiny of resume and SOP, a paper shall be sent to the applicant. The applicant shall be asked to send a review report to the Editorial Board within 24 hours. Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of the quality of the review report.
