2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and **every** high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity **every thought** to the obedience of Christ; **DC 6:16b** Behold, I do not condemn you, go your ways and sin no more: perform with soberness the work which I have commanded you; look unto me in **every thought**, doubt not, fear not:

Wednesday: Ponder the prophesy of this gospel going back to the House of Israel D&C 12:5a-b Behold, I am Jesus Christ the Son of the living God, who created the heavens and the earth; a light which cannot be hid in darkness; 5b wherefore, I must bring forth the fullness of my gospel from the Gentiles unto the house of Israel. Jacob 3:127 Graft in the branches; begin at the last, that they may be first, and that the first may be last, and dig about the trees, both old and young, the first and the last, and the last and the first, that all may be nourished once again for the last time.

Thursday: Ponder individually and collectively our commitment to being prepared Matt 24:49-51 And what I say unto one, I say unto all men; Watch, therefore, for ye know not at what hour hour Lord doth come. 50 But know this, if the good man of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have

suffered his house to have been broken up; but would have been ready. 51 Therefore be ye also ready; for in such an hour as ye think not, the Son of Man cometh.

<u>Friday: Ponder that point in time when you were able to exclaim, "Thou art the Christ the Son of the living God."</u>

John 11:17-27 And when Jesus came to Bethany, to Martha's house, Lazarus had already been in the grave four days. 18 Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off. 19 And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother. 20 Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him; but Mary sat still in the house. 21 Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. 22 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee. 23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. 25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life; he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live; 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? 27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord; I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world. Matthew 16:17 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. Luke 10:23 All things are delivered to me of my Father; and no man knoweth that the Son is the Father, and the Father is the Son, but him to whom the Son will reveal it.

III Nephi 8:50-55 50 And it came to pass that when Jesus had spoken these words unto his disciples, he turned again unto the multitude, and said unto them, Behold, verily, Verily, I say unto you, Ye must watch and pray always, lest ye enter into temptation; 51 For Satan desireth to have you, that he may sift you as wheat; therefore ye must always pray unto the Father in my name; and whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, which is right, believing that ye shall receive, behold it shall be given unto you.
