



RV Space Information

1-10: Water and sewer, 20 & 30 amp hookups, gravel spaces

11-14: Water and sewer, 20, 30, and 50 amp hookups, longer concrete spaces

15: Sewer, 20, 30, and 50 amp hookups, water could run a hose from spot 20 with splitter, smaller concrete space (~13 ft long)

16-19: Water and sewer, 20, 30, and 50 amp hookups, smaller concrete spaces (~13 ft long)

20-21: Water, no sewer, 20 amp hookups, smaller concrete spaces (~13 ft long)

22: Water, no sewer, 20, 30, & 50 amp hookups, smaller concrete space (~13 ft long), but long enough (in grass) for a larger camper

23: Water, no sewer, 20 amp hookup-extension cords needed, smaller concrete spaces (~13 ft long)

24: No water, no sewer, 20 amp hookup-extension cords needed, smaller concrete spaces (~13 ft long)

25: Water with a long hose (with splitter from spot 1), no sewer, 30 amp-extension cord needed, gravel space

26: Water with a long hose (with splitter from spot 1), sewer, 30 amp-extension cord needed, gravel space

(If 1, 25, and 26 are all used, two hose splitters will be needed)

Pump House: Water with a hose, no sewer, 30 amp hookup

Old Basketball Court: Water, no sewer, 20 amp (could be 50 with adjustments before hand)

Cabin Space Information

1-15 each have 4 bunk beds, sleeping 8 people. They also have a dresser, mirror, clothes hanging bar, and broom and dust pan.

1-8 are close to the pool, bathrooms, and dining hall.

9-15 are closer to the tabernacle, but require a walk up a big hill to get to the bathroom.

16-19 are double cabins (16 with 17 and 18 with 19). They are divided with a wall in the middle and have 2 bunk beds on each side, sleeping 4 people per side.

20 is a smaller cabin with 2 bunk beds, sleeping 4 people.

16-20 do not have dressers, mirrors, or clothes hanging bars, but they do have a broom and dust pan.
