

# **Frequently Asked Questions for Kindergarten**

## **What are the days and hours of school?**

Monday – Thursday from 9:00am – 3:00pm and Friday from 9:00am – 11:30am

## **What is the daily schedule?**

## **What is taught in Kindergarten?**

Along with our regular curriculum, which you can find as a download on this website, we also teach our students a love for Jesus, to be citizens of a community, to take responsibility for their learning, their possessions, and their actions.

## **Are there assessments and report cards?**

Assessments are done in October, February, and May. We have parent-teacher conferences in November and March and reports cards are sent home in November, March and at the End of the Year.

## **Is lunch provided?**

Students bring their own lunch Monday – Thursday. We do not have a way to keep things cold so you should invest in a cold pack. We do not have a way to heat up food, but you can put almost anything in a thermos and it will still be warm when we have lunch.

## **What if my student has an allergy?**

We are a nut free school, and we can make accommodations for other allergies.

## **What if my student only likes to eat peanut butter sandwiches for lunch?**

There are alternatives to peanut butter such as, WOW butter which is made from soybeans and SUN butter which is made from sunflower seeds. Parents will also be provided with a Lunch Ideas for School paper at orientation.

## **What supplies does my student need?**

Each student should have a backpack and a lunch box. We also ask that each student brings 2 boxes of hand wipes, 1 box of Kleenex and 12 glue sticks. All other supplies are provided.

## **Can I volunteer in my child's classroom?**

We love to have volunteers in our school. Whether you want to volunteer on a weekly, monthly, bi-monthly, or just drop in we would love to have you here. We do require a background check for all our volunteers, and you must sign in and wear a badge each time you are volunteering.
