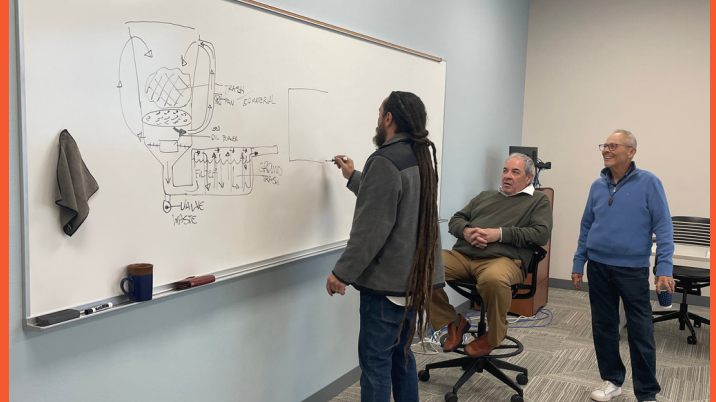

Exploring Innovative Solutions to Global Issues

Sage Green NRG in association with Janix Energy is proud to offer a patented solution for the conversion of a myriad of waste products that are currently becoming increasingly problematic (i.e. municipal solid waste, trash tires, plastics, food waste, woody mass, bio-solids etc.) to reduce carbon footprints while generating profits. Our solution is in the form of an improved gasification technology that converts biogenic and fossil fuel-based hydrocarbons into a synthetic natural gas which can be used to produce electricity, hydrogen fuel, or recombined to form low-sulfur synthetic crude oil for production of liquid fuels.

Camino Largo Community Development will be introducing a futuristic sustainable live-work community as part of reversing global warming and carbon footprints for financial and life prosperity. The community is designed with renewable energy, waste conversion system, current and emerging smart technologies.
