Brad Clark Calls for Cancellation of LRT

Brad Clark, City Councillor Candidate for Ward 9, is calling for the cancellation of the LRT. “I have confirmed that the Province of Ontario is indemnified should the current LRT request for proposal (RFP) process be cancelled. As such there is no risk of financial penalties to the City of Hamilton”, said Brad Clark.

“Therefore, I can unequivocally continue my opposition to LRT without fear of legal or financial penalties to taxpayers. There are far more pressing infrastructure needs across our city,” said Clark.

As former Minister of Transportation, Brad Clark is familiar with the provincial RFP application process. “When I was Minister, every RFP that was released contained an indemnification clause for the Ministry. I have been trying to verify that the process has not changed. Answers from the city were not forthcoming, so I reached out to my former colleagues at the Ministry of Transportation for confirmation. I have been reassured that cancelling the LRT project will not result in any financial penalties to the City of Hamilton.”

Clark said, “With the Province’s confirmed commitment of \$1billion for Hamilton’s road and transit infrastructure needs, I will advocate for an expedited implementation of the ten-year transit plan, bus rapid transit routes, the widening of Rymal Road, the Red Hill Valley Parkway and the Linc including centre barriers and the widening of the 403 interchange.”
