

Poway Volunteer Sheriff's Patrol Uniform Standards



Class A: Long sleeve shirt, blue slacks, polished black shoes, white T-shirt, black tie with clasp. Whistle optional.

Class B: Long sleeve shirt, blue slacks, black patrol boot/shoe, black turtleneck, dickie or white T-shirt. Blue or black Sheriff ball cap, Boonie hat or Campaign hat are optional. White Stetson is optional. Whistle is optional.

Class C: White short sleeve shirt, blue slacks or cargo pant, black patrol boot/shoe, white T-shirt. Blue or black Sheriff ball cap, Boonie hat or Campaign hat are optional. White Stetson is optional. Whistle is optional.

There is flexibility between Classes B & C. For example, long sleeve shirts may be worn with cargo pants. An extra utility belt may be worn to carry the radio, flashlight, and other items. Shoulder holsters are not permitted for volunteers.

Hair should be kept neat, clean, and well-groomed at all times. For men, hair may be cut in any style, as long as it does not extend beyond the top of the uniform shirt collar when the head is held erect.

1. Mustaches: All mustaches will be neat, clean and well-groomed at all times, especially as it relates to thickness. The length of any mustache shall at no time extend beyond the corner of one's mouth. Please see the below picture of Mark Emch, as the Standard. Handle-bar mustaches shall not be allowed.
2. Goatees: All goatees will be neat, clean and well-groomed at all times, especially as it relates to thickness. Please see the below picture of Robert Moberg, as the Standard.
3. Beards: All beards will be neat, clean and well-groomed, especially as it relates to thickness. Please see the below picture of Ed Ozmun, as the Standard. Long beards of any fashion shall not be allowed.
4. Pork-Chop Sideburns: Stand-alone pork-chop sideburns shall not be allowed.
