WE, the PEOPLE of the STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATIONS,
on First Day of September, A. D. 2024, 918, have seriously and deliberately considered
the present situation of this State, DO DECLARE, MAKE KNOWN, and ORDER:

Reassumption of Government Powers:

28



1. That the powers of government have been reassumed by the WE, the PEOPLE of the STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATIONS, as necessary for happiness and for the purpose of the Narragansett People to rescind their voluntary subjugation and all obligations of contracts to the Submission of the Chief Sachem of the Narragansett to Charles I, Published April 19, 1644, wherein it was declared: "Whereof moveth and bendeth our hearts with one consent, freely, voluntarily, and most humbly, to submit, subject, and give over ourselves, peoples, lands, rights, inheritances, and possessions whatsoever, in ourselves and our heirs, successively forever, unto the protection, care, and government of that worthy and royal prince, Charles, King of Great Britain and Ireland, his heirs and successors forever, to be ruled and governed according to those ancient and honorable laws and customs established in that so renowned realm and kingdom of Old England."

1. It is ordered on all hands, that all lands, inheritances, and possessions whatsoever of Nanhigganeuck, alias Narragansett, held in allodium for and by the United States of America, the United States, and its predecessor governing bodies—including the United Colonies of New England (New England Confederation), the Dominion of New England, the United Colonies, the Continental Congress, and under the Articles of Confederation and Perpetual Union—are hereby restored.

Consent to Hierarchy:

2. That We, the People of the Colony of Rhode-Island and Providence-Plantation, in New England, on the Continent of America, fully consent to the current hierarchy as recorded:
 1. Monarch: Sagamore Sachem of Nan-higga-ne-uck – Monarchy
 2. President in Sachem of the Unified Colonies of America in Narragansett-Bay, in New England, on the Continent of America, (Authorized Colony Agent for the entire Allodium and Society of We, the People)
 3. President in Sachem of the Narragansett Colony of Rhode-Island and Providence-Plantation, in the Narragansett-Bay, in New-England, on the Continent of America,



4. President of Rhode-Island and Providence-Plantations and the
Incorporation of Providence-Plantations in the Narragansett Bay in New
England, on the Continent of America, (Authorized Colony Agent for the
Governor and Company)

5. STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATIONS (WE, the
PEOPLE'S Representatives, Trustees, and Agents)

Grant of Complete Powers

3. That the President in Sachem of the Narragansett Colony of Rhode-Island and
Providence-Plantation, in the Narragansett-Bay, in New-England, on the Continent
of America, has been granted COMPLETE and ABSOLUTE authority of the
governments.

Supersession of Old Titles

4. That the Governor and Company of the English Colony of Rhode-Island and
Providence-Plantations, in New England, in America, will be superseded by the
Patent for Providence Plantation and the Incorporation of Providence-Plantations
in the Narragansett Bay in New England, along with the Commission to William
Coddington as Governor of the Islands of Aquidneck and Conanicut, with a new title
adopted: President of Rhode-Island and Providence-Plantations and the
Incorporation of Providence-Plantations in the Narragansett Bay in New England,
on the Continent of America.

Representation of We, the People

5. That the President in Sachem of the Narragansett Colony of Rhode-Island and
Providence-Plantation, in the Narragansett-Bay, in New-England, on the Continent
of America, in the Name and in the Behalf of the People, is the Representative of
the Nan-higga-ne-uck Monarchy, alias Narragansett, and We, the People.

Dissolution of the General Court of Election (1641)



6. It is ordered on all hands, that the General Court of Election held at Portsmouth, GOVERNMENT for Rhode Island, 1641, be DISSOLVED.

Dissolution of Tribal Authority Act

7. It is ordered on all hands, that An Act to Abolish the Tribal Authority of the Narragansett Tribe of Indians, and for Other Purposes, be DISSOLVED.

Dissolution of the Charter of the 'Indian Corporation'

8. It is ordered on all hands, that the Charter of the 'Indian Corporation' Narragansett Tribe of Indians and all variations of the 'Indian Corporation' be DISSOLVED.

Procedures for Addressing Violations:

9. In the event of a violation, an independent commission shall be established to investigate the matter. This commission will have the authority to recommend actions, including lawful proceedings, removal from office, or other measures deemed necessary to uphold the law and the principles outlined in this declaration.

Public Notification and Transparency:

10. All proceedings related to the enforcement of this declaration, including investigations and adjudications, shall be conducted transparently, and made available to the public to ensure accountability and trust in the government.

Oath of Office:

11. All representatives, officers, and public servants of the STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATION shall swear an oath of office, affirming their commitment to uphold this declaration, the Constitution for the United States of America, and to serve the We, the People with integrity and honor.

Periodic Review and Amendments:

12. This declaration shall be subject to periodic review every year by a special assembly of Representatives and Agents. Any amendments or changes deemed



necessary to uphold the principles and commitments outlined herein shall be proposed and ratified through a transparent and equal process.

Affirmation of Nonviolent Principles:

13. All measures taken to enforce this declaration and restore the proper functions of government shall be conducted peacefully and lawfully, with the utmost respect for the rule of law and the rights of all People.

Accountability for Transgressions:

14. Violation of Trust: Any individual or entity that seeks to undermine or transgress the principles set forth in this declaration, or to challenge the reassumption of government by WE, the PEOPLE, will be deemed in violation of the trust and commitment bestowed upon them by WE, the PEOPLE of the STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATIONS, and will face the full extent of the consequences as provided by law.

15. Government Cooperation: The previous government representatives of the State of Rhode Island will work in harmony with the We, the People to restore and maintain the necessary positions and functions required for effective governance. All representatives are hereby called upon to assemble with We, the People to guide and direct a future that best serves the interests of We, the People.

16. Binding Contract: This declaration serves as a binding contract, ensuring that any law created or enforced in violation of this Constitution and the principles herein will be met with the full force of the law. All branches of government must adhere to this contract, recognizing that any transgression against the WILL of WE, the PEOPLE or the Constitution for the United States of America will be considered a grave violation, subject to the most stringent lawful consequences.

WE, the PEOPLE of the STATE OF RHODE-ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE-PLANTATIONS, let this be known and established, our DECLARATION and ORDERS on this First Day of September, A.D. 2024
