Declaration of Claim

PATENT FOR PROVIDENCE PLANTATIONS—1643

Sagamore Sachim of Nanhigganeuck Have Appointed

President, - Champlain, Shareff S – Narragansett, Monarch Line of Champlain, Leslie A #206

"Governor in Chief, and Lord High Admiral of all Islands and other Plantations inhabited or planted by, or belonging to any His Majesty the King of England's subjects, within the Bounds, and upon the Coasts of America, And whereas there is a Tract of Land in the Continent of America aforesaid, called by the Name of the Narraganset-Bay, by the Indians called Nanhigganeuck, alias Narragansetts" - March 14, 1643

Nanhigganeuck Claim — "Free Charter of Civil Incorporation and Government for the Providence Plantations, in the Narragansett Bay, in New England, a free and absolute Charter of Incorporation, to be known by the Name of the Incorporation of Providence Plantations, in the Narraganset-Bay, in New-England.-Together with full Power and Authority to rule themselves, and such others as shall hereafter inhabit within any Part of the said Tract of land, by such a Form of Civil Government, as by voluntary consent of all, or the greater Part of them," - March 14, 1643,

Treaty - Submission of the Chief Sachem of the Narragansett to Charles I, "our hearts with one consent, freely, voluntarily, and most humbly, to submit, subject, and give over our selves, peoples, lands, rights, inheritances, and possessions whatsoever, in our selves and our heirs, successively forever, unto the protection, care, and government of that worthy and royal prince, Charles, King of Great Britain and Ireland, his heirs and successors forever, to be ruled and governed," - "19th day of April, 1644"
