Iron Baraga Conservation District has a partnership with the USDA's Natural Resource Conservation Service. Our staff works with local NRCS technicians to assist you with specialized advice for your natural resource concerns. NRCS staff can meet with you and help you learn about, and apply for Farm Bill programs, and financial assistance to meet your land management objectives.

Ask about cost share opportunities for High Tunnel Hoop Houses which can lengthen your growing season and aid in food production and revenue streams.

Wild Parsnip is a health hazard to anyone who comes in contact with the juices of this plant. If you have the juice of this plant on your skin and are exposed to sunlight you can develop serious rashes, burns and blisters. Children are especially vulnerable due to their tendency to play in or pick patches of pretty flowers. Please report all sightings of this plant to the Iron Baraga Conservation District at (906) 875-3765 or by emailing us if spotted in Iron, Baraga, Gogebic or Ontonagon Counties. **IF YOU ARE EXPOSED:** Immediately cover the exposed skin with clothing, do not allow sunlight to fall on areas of skin that have come in contact with the juices. As soon as possible remove contaminated clothing and wash all exposed skin with dish detergent to thoroughly remove the juices of this plant. Wash all contaminated clothing and equipment. Continue to keep the skin covered and away from direct sunlight for the next 72 hours. Phytophotodermatitis reactions will usually show up within 24 to 48 hours.
