Interested in Farm Bill Programs?

Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP): is intended to help producers access cost-share assistance in order to implement conservation practices. Based on a completed conservation plan, EQIP application will be based on the specific goals and concerns. Over 200 practices are part of EQIP and include everything from cover crops and seasonal high tunnels to erecting livestock fencing.

Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP): The CSP program is designed for producers that have already implemented conservation practices and want to extend their efforts further. For cost-share enhancements (or practices) that meet your land and management goals.

Paradise Plant (Daphne mezereum) This invasive has been spotted in Iron River & Bates Township. Handling the plant is very dangerous; the berries are highly toxic, and a rash or choking sensation can occur after prolonged exposure. It can grow up to 5 feet tall but seems to stay around 2-3 feet in our area. The leaves spiral along the woody-looking stem. Flowers are pink to purple, berries are bright red, and it blooms from April into May. Call (906) 875-3765 to report!
