I led a content-creation studio within CCTV designed to engage the community with production projects and learning opportunities. The Make Media Workshop hosted regular events open to the public which ranged from studio productions, work-in-progress screenings, day-long film challenges, skill-share opportunities, editing labs, office hours, and more. In addition, I was the lead on CCTV's in-house media projects, taught media production classes, oversaw our internship program, and managed CCTV's equipment inventory.

Project Highlights:

- Created and produced CCTV's first **Telethon** - a 10 hour live television marathon showcase of local talent. Scheduled and coordinated the 42 performers, 28 crew members, and staff member roles.
- Created **StudioLab** - a monthly studio shoot and class hybrid that is free and open to the public. StudioLab begins with a 30 minute crash course on using CCTV's TV studio, then, the class produces a show.
- Created, produce and host **The CCTV Vlog** - a fun, casual video series highlighting various aspects of CCTV.

In my time at CCTV, I've supervised over 30 interns, taught more than 70 classes, and have produced hundreds of videos.

Classes Taught Include: Intro to Premiere Pro, Intermediate Editing with Premiere Pro, Intro to Adobe After Effects, Lighting 101, DSLRs 101, Field Production 101, Beginning Studio Production, Intro to DaVinci Resolve, and many more.
